Attendance

Leave letters should be signed/counter signed by parents/guardians. Medical leave letters should be accompanied by medical certificate and to be produced in time. Prior permission must be obtained to avail of leave, failing which the leave letters should be submitted on the day of reporting back to the college or within two days from the commencement of leave, whichever is earlier.

Dress code

The spacious library is with a collection of about 51,601 books, 127 National and International Journals, 8333 e-journals and 1900 e-books. There are technical, general and reference books to cater to the needs of the various branches of study.

There are about 2900 CDs in the library which can be used in the library itself.

The Central Library consists of Reference Section, Journal Section, Digital Library, Reading Hall, Stack-Room and Binding Section. The library has unique collection of Encyclopedia, Handbooks, Textbooks, Journals, Video Cassettes and CD's, etc. to cater to the needs of various branches of study.

The Library is fully automated. It consists of modules of Acquisitions, Cataloguing, Circulation, Serial Control, Article Indexing & OPAC. Circulation system of books is based on Bar-Code. OPAC provide facilities to Staff & Students to access the Books and other Reading materials available in the library.

Reprography facility is available in the library to help the users take photocopy of the required library materials. There is a digital library with the student Project Reports and other College Publications. There is a library committee represented by the various departments to advise the librarian related to the requirement of books and journals.

Video programs on motivation, technology, innovation, entrepreneurship etc have been arranged and will be played on every working day between 4.15 p.m and 5.00 p.m at Audio Video Hall , SRM VEC Central Library.

The rules and regulations to be adhered in the library are given below. They are intended to regulate the use of library resources and will be reviewed periodically to meet the changing needs.

Membership

Membership is open to all the staff and students of the college.

Loss of Books

1. Loss of any book borrowed must be reported immediately to the Library in the prescribed form available at the Circulation Desk.
2. Lost books must be replaced by the user with the latest edition with overdue charges if any.

Reservation of Books

Members can reserve the books, which are already issued. The reserved books, after their return, will be kept at the counter for two days for issue to those who have reserved. If they fail to collect the books within two days, the books will be allotted to the members in the waiting list.

Access to e-Resources

The Library provides facilities to access IEEE, Elsevier Science Directory, JGATE (Science & Technology) and JGate (Management). Members are permitted to use this facility after entering the register maintained in the Digital Library.

No Dues Certificate

All student members should obtain 'No Dues Certificate' from the library at the end of every semester before getting the Hall Ticket.

Library Rules

8. Notwithstanding anything stated in these rules, the decision of the authorities of this institution shall be final and binding on all matters.
9. The Students shall not enter the College in inebriated condition failing which they will be expelled from College with immediate effect and will not be allowed in the College Campus.”

IMPORTANT NOTICE

RAGGING : AN OFFENCE

Ragging in any form, in any place or time is a Cognizable offence that will attract severe punishment including summary expulsion from the College / Institution / University.

Extract of Tamil Nadu Govt. Gazatte Extra ordinary dt. 29.1.97 (Bill No. 8 of 1997 Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act)

1. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, 'Ragging' means display of noisy, disorderly conduct, doing any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to a student in any educational institution and includes
 - (a) Teasing, abusing or playing practical jokes on, or causing hurt to such student or
 - (B) Asking the student to do any act or perform something which such student will not, in the ordinary course, willingly act or perform.
2. Ragging within or outside any educational institution is prohibited.
3. Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in abets or propagates "Ragging" within or outside educational institution, shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to 2 years and shall also be liable to a fine which may extend to Rs. 10, 000/-.
4. Any student convicted of an offence under section 4 shall also be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in other educational institutions.

Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, whenever any student complains of ragging to the Head of an educational institution, or to any other person responsible for the management of the educational institution, shall inquire into the same immediately and if found true shall suspend the student, who has committed the offence, from the educational institution.

SRM VEC Rules and Regulations for Students

1. To enforce discipline among students, dress code of the college is strictly adhered to. They should attend the college in formal dress. The boys are not supposed to wear jeans and T-shirts when they attend college and girls should wear churidars with pinned dupattas.
2. Students should wear black or brown shoes only.
3. Boys should come to the College neatly shaven.
4. Students should wear valid college ID cards with tags and it should not be kept in the pockets/bags. Otherwise, they will not be permitted to enter the campus and attend the classes.
5. All undergraduate (UG) students should wear laboratory coats whenever they attend laboratory classes.
6. If a student is found using mobile phone in the class, he/she will be either suspended for 10 working days or imposed a penalty of Rs.2000/-. In the beginning of every semester, every student should register for that semester as per Registration Form with an Undertaking, failing which the student will not be permitted to attend classes.
7. In the beginning of every semester, every student on roll should register/enroll for that semester as per the Registration Form with an Undertaking, failing which the student will not be permitted to attend the classes.
8. Students should be regular and punctual in attending classes and all activities connected to the college. Late comers will not be allowed to attend classes under any circumstances.
9. If a student does not attend college without prior permission for more than three days consecutively, it will be intimated to the parents. Parents should meet the HOD concerned along with the student and should give a written undertaking, as per Format - A, confirming regular attendance thereof, and then only the student will be permitted to attend further classes.
10. Continuous Assessment Tests will be conducted for all the departments on common dates as per the schedule, communicated in the beginning of every semester.
11. If a student fails to attend the Continuous Assessment Tests the student will be awarded zero mark. Retest will be conducted only for the student with genuine reason.
12. Internal marks will be awarded purely based on the performance in the Continuous Assessment Tests, as per the SRM VEC Regulations (2019 & 2023). (Refer Sections 11 & 12 for more details).
13. At the end of every Continuous Assessment Test, the progress report as per Format - B, will be sent by post / handed over to students for getting the signature of their parents and the same should be returned to the coordinator within a week.

14. During the working hours, students should be in their respective classrooms / laboratories or library. They should not loiter or gather in common places like portico, pathways and canteen.
15. Attendance percentage is calculated as,

$$\% \text{ Attendance} = (\text{Total no. of periods attended} / \text{Total no. of periods conducted}) \times 100.$$
16. However, students having less than 75% of attendance will be counseled by the Class Coordinator. In turn, the student should submit an undertaking to the Coordinator as per Format - C, confirming regular attendance, thereof.
17. Indiscipline of students, in any form, will be viewed very seriously and such students will be issued TC, irrespective of their academic performance.
18. As per the rules of the Anna University, a student who fails to maintain a minimum of 75% of attendance, in a particular semester, will be detained. Such student is not eligible to appear for the End Semester Examinations in that semester and he/she cannot continue his/her studies in the subsequent semester. He has to redo the courses of that semester along with his juniors in the subsequent academic year. However, he/she will be permitted to appear for arrear examinations.
19. Students, who have three or more arrears, will be considered as poor performers and special classes will be conducted for such students from 4.15 p.m. to 5.15 p.m. on all working days, if required. All the poor performers should attend such special classes without fail. Such of those poor performers, who secure more than 75% of marks in all the subjects in the Continuous Assessment Tests conducted subsequently, will be exempted from attending special classes. However, if such students do not perform well in the next Continuous Assessment Tests, they have to continue attending special classes. All the poor performers should abide by this rule of SRM VEC and TC will be issued to the defaulters.
